TERMS AND CONDITIONS

BIDDING: Each animal on which there are two or more bids will be sold to the highest bidder. Consignors may bid on and/or purchase any animal in the sale. Online bidders and bidders list will be reviewed before the sale.

The sale manager reserves the right to decline bidders who are not in good standing with the American Beefalo Associations. This would likely stem from a previous NON-PAYMENT transaction with the ABA or its members.

TERMS: Terms of the sale are cash or valid check. Make checks payable to American Beefalo Association. Settlement must be made immediately after completion of the sale and prior to removing animals from the facility.

HANDLING: All animals will be maintained prior to the sale at the absolute risk of the seller. All animals are to be maintained at the purchaser's risk as soon as they are sold.

BREEDING GUARANTEE: All animals sold are guaranteed to be breeders by the seller. Females safe in calf or with calves at side are considered breeders. Females which have been bred less than sixty days will be sold as serviced and not guaranteed safe in calf. Females sold as open are also guaranteed. If a female sold as safe in calf proves to be open at the time of sale, seller shall have the option of return of the heifer to get safe in calf or replace with bred females of equal value or refund of full purchase price either of which will be considered full settlement.

Any animal that has not proven itself a breeder within six (6) months after date of sale, if in healthy condition, may be returned to the seller at the seller's expense. Should the animal fail to prove a breeder within six (6) months trial by the seller, the seller, at his option may either return the purchase price to buyer or replace the animal with another of equal value in full settlement and satisfaction of all claims. If proved to be a breeder, buyer will pay return to his farm.

All complaints regarding breeding difficulties must be reported in writing by the buyer to the seller within the limit specified above and animals returned must be disease free and in good condition.

REGISTRATION: Registration certificates on Beefalo animals will be transferred to the purchaser by the seller. Breeding dates and sires on bred females will be furnished by the seller to the purchaser for recording. A.I. certificates must be furnished with any animals that were artificially inseminated in order to register the animal.

HEALTH: For states that are not Tuberculosis and Brucellosis free: The owner of each animal sold will have such animals tested for Tuberculosis and Brucellosis no sooner than thirty (30) days prior to sale date, and only animals free from such diseases will be permitted to be sold. All females will have been calfhood vaccinated for Brucellosis. Proper certification will be furnished to the purchaser by the seller guaranteeing the animal sold to be free from above diseases. Animals officially calfhood vaccinated for Brucellosis and not over eighteen (18) months old are exempt from test. The owner of each bull over 12 months of age is required to provide a negative Trichomoniasis to be entered into the show and sale. Trich tests require over a week for processing between testing date and results.

BREEDING CONDITION: Animals consigned to the Show & Sale are expected to be in breeding condition. Animals that are not in breeding condition will not be eligible to attend the event. Sale manager has authority to accept or reject any animals that are not up to the American Beefalo Association standards.

NOTICE: It is the sole responsibility of the consignor or seller to make positive identification of his animals at point of sale and to match identification information furnished to the sale in preparation of the sale catalog. In the event of default in any of the Terms and Conditions covering this sale by either the buyer or the seller, it shall be the responsibility of the buyer or the seller to investigate any action necessary to bring about a fair settlement of any claims arising from the sale and to be responsible for any or all costs involved therein.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Announcements from the auction box will take precedence over the printed matter in this catalog and all other announcements.

PARTICIPATION: The Show and Sale Manager reserves the right to deny participation for any reason. He/She reserves the right to disqualify any entrant or winner who does not adhere to the rules applicable to the show or sale in which he or she entered or who gains an unfair advantage through fraud or unsportsmanlike conduct in participating in the show or sale.

LIABILITIES: All persons who attend the show and/or sale do so at their own risk and neither the owner nor the sale manager assumes liability, legal or otherwise for any accidents that may occur.

CONTRACTS: The above Terms and Conditions shall constitute a contract between the buyer and seller of each animal sold.






