## Cattle Health Record Requirements

### C.V.I. - Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Paper)

### Identification

Official I.D. – all sale cattle are required to have an “840 \_\_\_” tag. That tag number should be listed on the C.V.I. along with the tattoo number.

➡ The Sale Lot Number must be written in the top right corner of the C.V.I.

Each **SALE** animal should have its own C.V.I. – One per animal written within 30 days of the sale.

C.V.I.’s for **SHOW** cattle may list multiple animals.

### Testing

*Any testing/results for the sale animals should be recorded on the C.V.I.*

BVD-PI Test – Required for all cattle entering the facility

Trichomoniasis –

All non-virgin bulls must have a trich test regardless of age.

Bulls over 18months of age, regardless of Virgin-Status, must have a NEGATIVE Trich Test within 30days of the sale. These bulls should also have no exposure to females between the day of the test and sale day.

Virgin Bulls less than 18months of age should have a virgin bull statement on the C.V.I.

*\*\*Texas requires testing on all bulls over 12months if you are selling a 12month old bull and have a possible buyer in TX please have a Trich Test performed.*

Pregnant Females – Please note age of pregnancy. If there is a calf at side please note “Calf at side” on the C.V.I.
